

When Quoting from the NIV Bible: Permissions

If you are quoting from the NIV Bible, be sure to follow the specific guidelines for use. Zondervan's policy in giving permissions has been provided as follows:

Please note these guidelines apply to both commercial and non-commercial use of the NIV. The NIV text may be quoted in any form (written, visual, electronic, or audio), up to and inclusive of five hundred (500) verses or less without written permission, providing the verses quoted do not amount to a complete book of the Bible, nor do verses quoted account for 25 percent (25%) or more of the total text of the work in which they are quoted, and the verses are not being quoted in a commentary or other Biblical reference work. This permission is contingent upon an appropriate copyright acknowledgement.

All NIV quotations must be completely accurate to the NIV text, including all appropriate punctuation, capitalization, etc. unless specifically approved to the contrary prior to publication.
